- Consortium led by Research in Practice, comprising:
 - The Tavistock and Portman NHS Foundation Trust
 - Goldsmiths, University of London
 - University of Sussex
- Supported by network of Local Delivery Partners including D2N2 and South Yorkshire Teaching Partnerships and Greater Manchester Social Work Academy and HEIs in TPs
- Mix of f2f, small group and individual learning, learning needs evaluations, supplementary reading.
